EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING – MARCH 11, 2010

CALL TO ORDER

The Executive Board of the Pennsylvania High School Speech League was called to order at 1:00 PM, on Thursday, March 11 in Meeting Room 2, Degenstein Campus Center, Susquehanna University with the following members present: Carl Askew, Lisa Bompiani-Smith, Keith Brosious, Stacey Cawley, Robert Casey, David Long, Michael Nailor, Kate O'Halloran, William Murray, Hugh Ringer, Alice Ursin, Beth Young, Larry Augustine, Executive Director, and Sandra Saxman, Secretary. Excused from the meeting were Neil Strine and Reed Messmore.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the July 11, 2009 meeting were approved. Motion: Ms. O'Halloran. Second: Mr. Nailor. Mr. Nailor made an announcement that one of the topics for Parliamentary Debate was being deleted for the State Tournament. That topic was *Resolved: That this house believes that the World Trade Organization accept China.*

ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Mr. Augustine welcomed everyone to the meeting and reminded board members that the agenda for this meeting is designed to handle State Tournament matters and not for general PHSSL items.
2. Mr. Augustine gave everyone the telephone numbers for the meeting room, chapel foyer for registration and the tab rooms for the weekend.
3. Mr. Augustine also announced that immediately following this meeting the dividers between Meeting Rooms 2 & 3 will be opened so the packets can be assembled for the tournament.
4. Mr. Augustine announced that the terms of Mr. Askew, Mr. Casey, Mr. Long and Ms. Ursin expire at the end of the 2009-2010 fiscal year. Mr. Askew and Mr. Casey are not returning to the Executive Board, however, they will be willing to come and work the State Tournament. An announcement will be made during the Friday opening meeting that anyone who is interested in running or anyone wishing to nominate someone to the Board for a 3-year term should let Mr. Murray, Ms. O'Halloran, Ms. Cawley, any Board member or Mr. Augustine know.

RADIO SCRIPT #1

House Democratic leaders are pushing to finish work on health legislation and hold a climactic vote in the next three weeks. Their aim is to overcome reluctance from rank-and-file lawmakers while answering President Obama's challenge for swift action. House Majority Leader Steny Hoyer said Thursday that Democrats would like to get a final vote by March 29. Democratic leaders are having to deal with many undecided lawmakers who want to see the fine print before making a decision. Hoyer said final language and a cost estimate should come back from the Congressional Budget Office by the end of next week.

A string of explosions ripped through Baghdad Thursday, targeting early voters and killing 17. The blasts raised tensions in a city already nervous as early ballots are cast for Sunday's parliamentary elections. Insurgents have threatened to use violence to disrupt the elections, which will determine who oversees Iraq as U.S. forces continue to leave.

Two Exeter men were arraigned Thursday on charges they stole clothing from a vehicle. 43-year old Troy Yanchick, and 47-year old Adam Hindmarsh, 47, both of Exeter, were charged with theft, criminal conspiracy to commit theft, criminal mischief, disorderly conduct and public drunkenness. Hindmarsh was further charged with possession of a controlled substance, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Both men were released on \$5,000 bail.

Burt Reynolds' manager says the actor has been released from a Florida hospital after a planned heart bypass operation. Erik Kritzer said Wednesday that Reynolds had been scheduled for the operation for over a month. He says the star of "Smokey and the Bandit," "Deliverance" and "Boogie Nights" told him that he has a – quote - great motor with brand new pipes – end quote, and is feeling great. Reynolds spent time in a Florida rehab center for treatment for painkiller abuse following back surgery in 2009.

RADIO SCRIPT #2

New jobless benefit claims fell last week in a sign that layoffs may be easing as the economy slowly recovers. Meanwhile, retailers reported Thursday that sales rose in February by the largest amount since November 2007. The reports provide fresh evidence that the economy is steadily growing, but it's not clear when that improvement will translate into new hiring. The stock market ticked up on the news. The Dow Jones industrial average rose by about 20 points in morning trading.

New York Mets shortstop Jose Reyes was scratched from Thursday's lineup for follow-up lab work related to his team physical. Reyes said Thursday after a second round of blood work that he feels fine and it's not related to the torn hamstring that sidelined him most of last season. Reyes was removed from Tuesday's loss against the Tampa Bay Rays along with several other regular starters because of wet field conditions.

Facebook chief executive Mark Zuckerberg says he is in no hurry to launch an initial public offering for the popular social networking site. He claims the company will go public eventually, but that there is no rush to do so right now. Facebook, which turned cash flow positive last year, could see revenue of between 1.2 billion dollars and two billion dollars this year. Facebook's 2008 revenue is estimated at between 600 and 700 million dollars. Facebook was founded in 2004 by the 25-year old Zuckerberg, in his Harvard University dorm room. The Palo Alto, California-based company currently employs 1,200 people and has more than 400 million users.

More than 250 silver coins dating back to the time of Alexander the Great were unearthed in northern Syria Thursday. Youssef Kanjo, (YOU-seff KAHN-joe) who is the head of archaeological excavations in the city of Aleppo (ah-LEP-poe), said the coins were discovered two weeks ago when a man was digging the foundations of his new home. The coins date from the Hellenic period, which ranges from the fourth to the first centuries B.C. after Macedonian warrior-king Alexander the Great spread Greek culture into the Middle East and beyond.

INSURANCE STATEMENT

(For those of you who have not yet sent in their Certificate of Insurance)

Susquehanna University requires that individuals or groups using University facilities need to file a Certificate of Insurance with the school. This is not anything major to comply with, but it is an important matter that all coaches/directors must give attention to.

To help simplify matters below is a printed memorandum, which you can send to your Business Manager. He/she and/or your school's insurance carrier should be familiar with the Certificate of Insurance. One important item, which must be stated on the Certificate, is that Susquehanna University must be named as "An Additional Insured."

You must have the Certificate of Insurance filed in the State Office before you can attend the Drama Festival and/or the State Tournament. One filing annually will take care of the entire year.

Organizations or groups wishing to use Susquehanna University facilities are required to provide a Certificate of Insurance listing Susquehanna as "An Additional Insured." The policy must show that the organization or group is insured for \$300,000 bodily injury, and \$50,000 property damage during the time in which the facilities are being utilized.
